Here it is. 8:22pm on [REDACTED] night, and I have made a phone call. Almost every [REDACTED] night for the past two or three weeks to the sheriff's department, because we have a group of ATVs are side by side, they're, they're offered vehicles as well they are they're not street [REDACTED]. They have highly modified motorcycle engines in them, they're very large motorcycle engines, they're not mufflers. My fault, by any stretch of imagination. They're [REDACTED] up several sort of failure to off the ground. And they have stud tires. And these are vehicles that are, that were never designed to be used on the local or the county roads isn't the federal road system. Government paved roads. They were not never designed to be used on paved roads periods they were meant to be used in areas of wilderness, like in Utah, Colorado, out west where you have vast stretches of land and people do do they do rock crawling and dune buggy riding and all sorts of fun, recreational vehicle stuff. But getting back to the point. For the past three weeks in a row. I've called the marketing department, three weekends in a row I call the market share supplement. And I've complained because you have a group of them, our TVs out here. And they are extremely loud. I can hear them from half a mile away, if not a mile away. They're louder than the TV at my house, we can actually be inside of our televisions inside our house all the doors close all the windows closed air conditioner running, and have the TV go going TV blaring, and these vehicles are so loud that we can hear them over the TV. They. We can't even have a conversation without, you know, without being with you know if we had a conversation while these vehicles are driving around, we would not be able to hear the conversation there's that loud. And when I say but it's not [REDACTED] one vehicle. They're about three or four of them that ride. All right. Together, they ride at night. And they're like, they came in one night I have a met at like 1130 at night, coming, coming in, and they go out and morning. And there's three of them. So it's not [REDACTED] like one close group. And they fly. They definitely don't they fly faster than you know well faster than my car traverses the road they're, they're traversing the road at a faster pace pace going around 40 miles per hour, you know, [REDACTED] managing 40 or 45 miles per hour, so they're really kicking it extremely loud. And since about. 4pm today. I have [REDACTED] nothing but these vehicles going up and down the county road from the back of my property, which is a pretty good distance. It would be consistent several st box. It's 32 acre piece of property. And so that's from ever 600 [REDACTED] away. I'm able to hear these things and that's all I've [REDACTED] for the past several hours for about three four hours. They're [REDACTED] been going nonstop around back and forth. I've been hearing a what sounds like a little dirt bike off road

bike. Go through here at an extremely fast pace. And it's a, it's been tough. It's [REDACTED] been rough real rough. So, that's what we've been experiencing. I've called the sheriff's I called the sheriff's about last time last the last two or three times. I called the sheriff about it. Um, They said that it was up to the sergeant on duty, whether they would actually do anything, whether they would actually send out somebody or not. And, which kind of directly goes [REDACTED] the policy that I was told that they send out that every time someone calls are required to send somebody out. But they said that it's because of the corona virus because of kovat 19 and Corona virus

that were the pandemic that's currently going on. They are no longer sending any the officers out unless they are approved to do so. So, what it appears like is that we are. Is that the county is in a moment of lawlessness, where the law is picking and choosing what if you what issues the calls the answer, and what calls, they do not answer. And that's [REDACTED] kind of interesting that now they don't they [REDACTED] in the past two times I've called they haven't even said, I mean like I've sat outside and waited, waited for the sheriff to arrive, and they never arrived, they never came down the road. They [REDACTED] ignored my phone call, which is really disheartening. You know it's not like I'm [REDACTED] creating stuff for them to do. And I'm not [REDACTED] trying to get somebody in trouble. Like, I'm [REDACTED] trying to [REDACTED] peace and quiet and the serenity of my home that I've [REDACTED] for over 30 something years. That is now being infiltrated and invade and invaded by these offroad vehicles. I've also reported to him about a group of vehicles that are drag racing on the culvert, that's another thing that's getting annoying, as I'll get out. Is that you had this, because there's one truck in particular that's it's a brand it's a newer dodge pickup truck, white with black tire black rims black tires, black grille, and it has it. It has to have a flow [REDACTED] I think it's what's called a flow [REDACTED] flow [REDACTED] exhaust system on it that's extremely loud. And that's another vehicle that you know we can and we're having difficulty [REDACTED] the quiet, the quietness of our home. Because every time that vehicle decides to pull out onto the haystack his engine out, you know, and pretty much performing. I mean in all seriousness, he's performing a quarter mile, a quarter mile track every time he comes out of [REDACTED] He performed a quarter mile drag from my house. And that's another issue that I've called him about. And you know that you're not sending anyone else. You know, since they're not sending anyone else over the RTV thing, which is the lesser of my concerns. They're definitely not gonna be sitting anyone else out over this drag racing issue. And so at this point. They're not gonna do anything it appears that they're not gonna do anything about it, especially in this COPPA 19 issue. So I'm [REDACTED] going to collect all my [REDACTED] together. And [REDACTED] document as much evidence as I can. And then I'm going to try my best to submit the video to them to so that way they are fully aware of what's going on. You know, if this happened in from their house, I find it [REDACTED] to believe that they were [REDACTED] ignored. It happened from their house. But it appears that if it happens from someone else's. They don't really care, which is, you know, really disheartening. I also have also suspect that they're had [REDACTED] because of the looks I've been given, and something else I kind of suspect that there is a that they are aware of the person but you actually know the individual who's doing it. And, or [REDACTED] [REDACTED] don't care to enforce the law, but I did, um, I did look it up. I did look up the information and to see if these vehicles were at all considered to be street [REDACTED] and by far and most definitively they're not. They're not through strict [REDACTED] they should not be on the roads, and they should especially not be the disrupting serenity in the peace of people's homes. You know, this is something I've been trying to get them on, get had something done about for years, and I finally got the evidence, and the gumption together to to do something about it. And it appears Now like I said before that the law enforcement is [REDACTED] not concerned about it during the scope of the 19th thing. And that we are in fact experiencing

a moment of lawlessness, where the police authorities are not concerned about enforcing the law. And they're only concerned with maintaining a priority of what they consider to be priority cases, which is rather disheartening. You know, usually, if an individual shows



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their willingness, or their acceptance to breaking the law. You're breaking one law, the chances are, and the probabilities are that they are willing to break other laws. And so once you have that set of laws that are constantly being violated that the police no longer care to enforce. Usually what that entails is that, that there are other laws that are also being broken that are not enforcing, or they are not aware of. Because you know, so anyway. All right. It's now a 33.
