And so I was hurting. I was hurting first and I needed to pick some equipment but in the meantime, I couldn't, you know, my [REDACTED] was getting was getting out of hand had gotten out of hand. And I needed to find a way to to prevent people from driving up in my [REDACTED] because we were having that that was occurring. People were driving up in my [REDACTED] They were turning around in the middle of the front [REDACTED] and everything and you know, that compacts the soil, and that's not good for the [REDACTED] that leaves indentations and everything and I'm not, you know, it's nothing, not something I don't want to happen. So I was trying to stop that. from happening. And I was working on building something and then about that time a black Tahoe came up the title and it was it was the type driven by the Sheriff's Department. And I had seen some some sheriff's going down the road a little bit earlier. So it's one What the [REDACTED] going on? And I I suppose Hey, can I do something?
